




What have I learned today?



Patterns

Objectives
To draw horizontal, vertical lines on a sheet to make a simple pattern with the help of lines

Resource kit
Crayons or oil pastels in yellow, red, black and blue

Core vocabulary
Patterns, horizontal, vertical, oil pastels, crayons

Instructions

1. Fill the background with yellow colour.
2. Draw five horizontal lines from one side to the other, on the sheet with red colour.
3. Draw five vertical lines from upside down on the sheet with blue colour.
4. Put ten dots anywhere in the squares, so made, with black colour.
5. Share your line pattern with your classmates.
6. Display your line pattern in the display corner.

What have I learned today?

Objective:
Each activity starts with objective stating what we are going to draw. It is important to build the habit of setting objectives in children before starting the work.

Collage

Objective
To make a collage face using different materials

Resource kit
Buttons, tissue paper, paint, glue, brush

Core vocabulary
Collage, pasting, tear

Instructions

1. Paint the given face and let it dry.
2. Tear the tissue paper into small pieces (don't use scissors).
3. Paste the tissue paper pieces with glue for hair.
4. Use buttons for eyes.
5. Use paint for the lips and nose.
6. Share your work with your classmates.
7. Display your work in the display corner.

Printing

Objective
To make leaf prints

Resource kit
Roller, leaf, paint, newspaper

Core vocabulary
Roller, leaf printing

Instructions

1. Take a leaf.
2. Dip the leaf in the paint.
3. Put the leaf on the sheet.
4. Roll the roller over the leaf.
5. Remove the leaf from the sheet.
6. Let the sheet dry for sometime.
7. Share your work with your classmates.
8. Display your work in the display corner.

Colouring

Objective
To colour the given picture

Resource kit
Oil pastels in brown, green and blue

Core vocabulary
Tree, trunk, leaves

Instructions

1. Fill the background with blue colour.
2. Colour the trunk brown.
3. Colour the leaves green.
4. Share your work with your classmates.
5. Display your work in the display corner.

New words which children are going to read in every activity are mentioned separately so that they can learn them.

Clay

Objective
To make finger hats with clay or play dough

Resource kit
Play dough, thin markers

Core vocabulary
Family members, finger hats, home

Instructions

1. Take some amount of clay and roll it.
2. Draw faces of your mother, father, brother, sister one on each finger.
3. Place little amount of clay on each finger to make small finger hats.
4. Ask all family members to wish each other.
5. Show your family to your classmates.
6. Share the learning with your family members at home.

Objective
To draw an apple



Resource kit
Apple (real), oil pastels

Core vocabulary
Teacher to make groups of four or five children and to arrange one big apple for each group.

Instructions

1. Observe the apple; its colour, texture, size and shape.
2. Draw the apple on the given sheet.
3. Colour the apple.
4. Fill the background with any light colour.
5. Share your drawing with your classmates.
6. Display your work in the display corner.

Patterns

Objective
To make patterns with the help of card paper

Resource kit
Card paper pieces in varying thickness to cut greeting cards, invitation cards, shoe boxes, file cover etc. to make small cards.

Core vocabulary
Patterns, upright, little

Instructions

1. Cut the given sheet in yellow.
2. Cut card upright and dip just a little into paint, as shown in picture 2.
3. Press the card onto the sheet to print.
4. Repeat this process with different card paper pieces to make beautiful patterns.
5. Share your work with your classmates.
6. Display your work in the display corner.

Objective
To draw a school building

Resource kit
Brush, paint, card paper

Core vocabulary
School, building, structure

Instructions

1. Draw the structure of school building.
2. Colour the building with the brush.
3. Paint this landscape.
4. Share your work with your classmates.

Objective
To make a collage nest

Resource kit
Old newspapers, glue, oil pastels

Core vocabulary
Strips, overlapping, nest

Instructions

1. Take a sheet of newspaper.
2. Tear the sheet into strips and glue them together as shown in picture 2.
3. When your nest is ready draw a bird.
4. Fill the background.
5. Share your work with your class fellows.
6. Display your work in the display corner.
